in the home. He brought examples of different orchid groups that might be suitable for home orchid culture based on light, humidity, air movement available, and water requirements. A few of the ones he discussed were smaller Cattleyas, Phalaenopsis, Masdevallias, and Paphiopedilums. He likes cypress mulch with added sponge rock for potting mix and finds he only has to pot his plants every 2-3 years with that.
