

May 2024 Meeting Notes

The meeting started with a welcome and introduction from SCOS President Clay Owens and recognition of some new members to our society. Clay gave a review of the Western North Carolina Orchid Society Asheville show which was held April 12-14. Their theme was "House of Orchids" and the color flow in the WNCOS's exhibit was particularly impressive. WNCOS won best exhibit but SCOS got second place.


Next, Clay gave a review of the Triad Orchid show in High Point, North Carolina where the theme was "Splendor of Orchids" and included five society exhibits. The stand-out individual display was by Tammy Goldberg, which was called "Moon Gate" and was judged by AOS. The show was held at High Point University which has an impressive conservatory that includes an orchid room.

Clay gave a recap of the SCOS show held April 26-28. We had eight exhibits, three orchid vendors, and unique Ikebana displays. SCOS won best exhibit. We are immensely thankful for all volunteers who helped with the planning and set up, and a huge thank you especially goes out to our hard-working president, Mr. Clay Owens!

The Society will hold its summer orchid auction this year on June 15th and is asking for any donations.

We discussed some field trip planning which would be a day trip to the Asheville/ Pisgah Falls area, where we would visit Looking Glass Orchids and Owen's Orchids on Saturday August 17th, in place of our regular meeting on August 18th. Both have promised to give discounts. Discussion included whether members would want to travel via group van or individually. The Society voted to travel individually. A featured video was shown in lieu of a speaker. It was an AOS video of terrariums by Daniel L. Geiger. He gave the definition of terrariums and types, discussed access locations, aesthetics and materials, positioning plants, biological problems (such as mold, moss, animals) and different environmental parameters for successful growing in terrariums.








